Qualifications

1. Member of Missio Dei Fellowship
2. Committed to the purpose and reflects the values and vision of Missio Dei Fellowship as outlined in the membership covenant and vision.
3. Genuine love for people with demonstrated relational skills. Hospitable and generous.
4. Ability to challenge and encourage others in their walk with the Lord.
5. Humble demeanor and teachable spirit; consistent and reliable.
6. Good verbal skills and possesses the ability to communicate in such a way that is clear and understandable with warmth and graciousness.
7. Solid reputation inside and outside the church meeting the requirements of 1 Tim 3, Titus 1 and Galatians 5.
8. Willing to be judged with greater strictness as a leader in the church (James 3:1).
9. Ability to lead up to 20 people.

Responsibilities

Shepherd: Care for and lead your community group toward growth as disciples of Jesus. Although you are not required to be the agent of the following for every member of your group, you should take responsibility that it is occurring.

1. Discipleship: Know the members of your group and encourage growth during the fellowship times with Scripture (sermon based), prayer, worship, confession and repentance.
2. Call on others in your group to shepherd one another and provide an atmosphere that is challenging and full of grace.
3. Designate members of your group to walk with new or non-believers through a basic discipleship plan
4. Membership: Encourage people to become committed members to the church and address lapsed expectations of members such as community involvement, service and giving.

Missiologist: Lead your group in the mission of the church.

1. Cast vision and pursue opportunities for neighborhood involvement.
2. Network with other groups in your neighborhood.
3. Grow your group through missional effort and seek to replicate to advance gospel opportunities

in your neighborhood.

4. Develop future leaders through apprenticing members of your group.

Administrator: Organize and plan so your group functions well.

Notes:

1. Although the group leader is responsible in all three areas he need not be in every one of these roles. Generally the leader will be the shepherd of the group but does not have to be its chief missiologist or administrator. These can be delegated to members of the group based on spiritual gifts and passion.
2. Other group member roles will be that of a care person and a missions person. It may be wise to delegate other roles to group members such as prayer leader and organizer, hospitality planning for treats and meals, event organizer and someone to call people who were not at the meeting to see how they are doing.
